Subject: Implementation plans for directives

In its 31st annual report on monitoring the application of EU law, the Commission states that it has drawn up implementation plans for certain directives in order to step up cooperation with Member States in the area of transposition.

The directives concerned include those on:

- the strengthening of the presumption of innocence and of the right to be present at trial in criminal proceedings;
- the establishment of procedural safeguards for children suspected or accused in criminal proceedings;
- provisional legal aid for suspects or accused persons deprived of liberty and legal aid in European arrest warrant proceedings.

Will the Commission summarise the impact of these plans and the progress made by Member States in transposing the directives in question?
