Subject: Review of Union legislation from the perspective of the rights of persons with disabilities

The EU has undertaken to improve the inclusion of people with disabilities in both the framework of the 2010-2020 Strategy and by complying with the UN Convention on the Rights of People with Disabilities.

The European Disability Forum has asked for the review of all existing EU legislation and future drafts to ensure they are aligned to the maximum extent possible with the aim of inclusion.

1. What is the Commission's position on this, given that this concerns more than 80 million EU citizens, or one in six of the population?
2. Could we envisage a procedure whereby automatic consideration is given to the inclusion of persons with disabilities, as is already the case in some Member States in the area of gender equality?
