Subject: EU humanitarian aid to Gaza

On 26 August 2014, the ceasefire came into effect in the Gaza Strip. However, the bombardment of Gaza caused massive destruction and certain Israeli sources today recall unjustified acts.

In the wake of these events, the European Union donated over 300 million euros to support the rebuilding of areas that had been destroyed. However, Israel, which is in charge of this rebuilding work, has blocked materials coming from other countries in order to boost its own economy! This is delaying the rebuilding process and leaving many Palestinians homeless.
