Subject: The use of electric cars

Cars are responsible for approximately 12% of emissions of CO₂, the most widespread greenhouse gas, in the EU. The use of electric cars is an excellent way of reducing the amount of exhaust gas that we are releasing into the atmosphere and they are easier and cheaper to maintain and use.

Is the Commission taking any steps to enable the exclusive use of electric cars for official EU purposes in order not only to set a positive example by reducing emissions of harmful gases, but also to encourage Member States to adopt similar measures for the sake of achieving the long-term goals in reducing emissions by the year 2050?
