Subject: Employment of people with disabilities

The average employment rate for persons with disabilities in the EU is more than 40%, and another big problem is the difference between the rates of employment of persons with disabilities and those without any limitation in working, which in some States, such as the Netherlands and Hungary, reaches about 40%.

With respect to the objectives of the European strategy for persons with disabilities for the period 2010-2020, can the Commission answer the following questions:

1. What measures is it implementing in order to assist people with disabilities in finding and keeping a job?
2. How does it assess the work and progress made by Croatia in the area of employment of persons with disabilities?
