Subject: End of Ebola epidemic in Liberia

On 9 May 2015, the World Health Organisation (WHO) announced the end of the Ebola epidemic in Liberia. On that occasion, the Commissioner responsible for humanitarian aid and crisis management declared that Europe should not rest on its laurels, and should concentrate on the two countries which are still suffering from Ebola, namely Sierra Leone and Guinea.

1. Does the Commission propose to intensify its support for the fight against the epidemic in Sierra Leone and Guinea?
2. Does the Commission propose to assist Liberia in overcoming the consequences of the Ebola epidemic, in particular in view of the repercussions of the disease on the economy of the country?
