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Subject: Electricity interconnection

Spain is underdeveloped in terms of electricity connection and the single energy market, and this poses a considerable risk in the medium and long term, given past and foreseeable energy crises. The current standards recommend having an interconnection infrastructures capacity that makes it possible to interconnect 10 % of the country's installed production. But the capacity in Spain is less than half that.

Since this is a problem that strategically affects the EU as a whole:

How will the Commission intervene?

What actions does it envisage, and over what timeframe?
