Subject: Rohingya immigrants in Gambia

The Gambian Government has said that it would take in all Rohingya boat people escaping oppression as part of its 'sacred duty' to alleviate the suffering of fellow Muslims flooding South-East Asia. The Government of the impoverished West African nation has appealed to the countries in the region to send these migrants to its shores, where it said it would set them up in refugee camps.

How is the Commission going to help Gambia sustain these immigrants?
