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Subject: Global Campaign for Education

Between 20 and 26 April 2015, the Spanish coalition of the Global Campaign for Education (GCE) took part in an action week, calling for fresh commitments to be made with regard to universal access to education by the year 2030. Although progress has been made, in 2015 some 100 million children throughout the world are still unable to complete their primary education.

As part of the campaign, some 29 events were held in more than 25 cities across Spain, with more than 170 schools and 7 000 pupils and teachers taking part in action to draw attention to the situation described above.
