Subject: eGovernment

The action plan for eGovernment EU 2011 – 2015 includes the creation of interoperability platforms such as a common framework for the management of electronic identity of citizens, encouraging innovation by funding pilot projects and improved use of open standards for computerised systems of public authorities in order to prevent dependence on specific suppliers.

The introduction of computerised administrative systems and electronic invoicing and certificates throughout the EU may create a saving of over EUR 50 billion at the European level.

Given that the first period envisaged for the implementation of this plan expires this year, how does the Commission assess the current implementation and success of the action plan?
