Subject: Chargeback systems

In its communication entitled 'Towards a renewed consensus on the enforcement of Intellectual Property Rights: An EU Action Plan', the Commission announced the publication of a Green Paper on the impact of chargeback and related schemes to tackle commercial-scale intellectual property infringements.
