Subject: Expulsion of a Spanish aid worker from Morocco for defending the GLTB community

On 3 June this year the Moroccan authorities arrested and deported the representative in Morocco of the Spanish association Novact for defending the GLTB community.

This expulsion represents one more chapter in the repression exercised by the Moroccan authorities against organisations and social movements in defence of human rights.

The Euro-Mediterranean Association Agreement between the European

Community and its Member States, on the one part, and the Kingdom of Morocco, on the other [Official Journal L 70 of 18.3.2000], lays down provisions on human rights.

1. Will the European Union demand that, in view of the increasing breaches of human rights by the Kingdom of Morocco, consideration should be given to revising this Agreement?
2. What specific measures will the European Union adopt in this regard?
