Subject: Human trafficking in Hungary

On 29 May 2015, the Council of Europe's Group of Experts on Action against Trafficking in Human Beings published a report on the situation in Hungary, after visiting the country.

The report shows that some progress has been made in recent years, in particular the passing of a law making human trafficking a criminal offence. However, it also highlights the lack of resources available to effectively combat the phenomenon, and strongly criticises the lack of assistance provided to the exploited victims.

How could the Commission support Hungary in combating human trafficking?
