Subject: VP/HR - Security situation in Sudan

According to the Sudanese website Nuba Reports the Government of Sudan has created a climate of fear and racism in universities, particularly in Khartoum and Omdurman. Since the end of April young people from Darfur have been the victims of a campaign of indiscriminate arrests, violence and sexual abuse carried out by the security services linked to the ruling party. Ethnically motivated violence is spreading while the President Omar al Bashir, who began a new mandate on 2 June 2015, refuses to start a dialogue with the opposition.

Does the VP/HR intend to start talks with the Government of Sudan about the security situation in Sudan?
