Subject: Plans for military intervention in Libya revealed by Wikileaks

According to documents published on the Wikileaks site on 29 May, the EU is planning military intervention in Libya on the pretext of combating illegal immigration networks and terrorist groups. Action will allegedly include the 'physical elimination' of traffickers, thus prolonging and expanding previous interference and aggression in the sovereign state, with dramatic destabilising effects throughout the region.

In the light of this information, what is the Council's assessment of these revelations and their grounding in fact, given that, should they be true, we are facing yet another flagrant violation of the UN Charter and international law?
