Subject: Solidarity clause

According to Article 222 (the Solidarity Clause) of the Lisbon Treaty, Member States 'shall act jointly in a spirit of solidarity' and mobilise all available instruments to assist a Member State (at its request) in the event of a terrorist attack or a natural or man-made disaster.

Would the clause be also applicable in case of hybrid warfare?

Has the solidarity clause already been invoked by any Member State? If not, has the Commission done any exercises/trials to ensure we are fully prepared in case it happens?
