Subject: PIÙ Europa project in the municipality of Marano, Naples

The *PIÙ Europa* integrated urban redevelopment programme was approved under Regional Executive Decision No 539 of 16 December 2011 with a view to substantially improving living conditions in urban areas in the Campania region, using funding available under the ERDF regional operational programme (ROP) for 2007-2013. The redevelopment works provided for under Decision No 170/2009 of Marano Municipal Council's Executive included an outline project for a 'Giardino dei cinque sensi' (gardens for the five senses) which was subsequently approved under Executive Decision No 55 of 27 May 2011. This project involves the laying out of public gardens with suitable amenities to compensate for the lack of recreational facilities at the nearby Paolo Borsellino primary school. However, there have been numerous reports of the works not being carried out in line with the original plans or the rules on pervious surfaces and on tree density, as part of the area is being concreted over in order to build a football pitch.

Is this project in keeping with the objectives set for the ERDF-funded 2007-2013 ROP for Campania, with particular reference to Objective 6.1?

What action will the Commission take if the project is found to be at odds with those objectives?
