Subject: Progress report on compliance with renewable energy targets

The Commission recently published its progress report on compliance with the renewable energy targets laid down in Directive 2009/28/EC. Although the data published demonstrate that 25 of the 28 Member States achieved their targets in 2011/12 and that 24 did so in 2013/14, the report advises that they will need to increase their efforts to meet the targets, in some cases through the use of cooperation mechanisms with other Member States – a system that has attracted little interest.

The report warns that regulatory uncertainty and administrative barriers are continuing to hinder private investment in the sector, however. As a result, additional measures are needed in a number of unspecified Member States – possibly including Spain – against which a series of complaints have been lodged owing to the change in the renewable energy regulatory framework.

- 1. Could the Commission specify what regulatory changes and countries it is referring to?
- 2. What action has it taken in the light of these changes?
- 3. What action does it intend to take to achieve the targets laid down in the Directive?
