Subject: Specific measures against the surge in xenophobia and anti-Semitism

In its answer to my question on the surge in anti-Semitism in Europe (E-001340/2015), the Commission made reference to the Report on the implementation of Framework Decision 2008/913/JHA, which states that the European Commission is engaging in bilateral dialogues with the Member States with a view to ensuring correct implementation of the provision.

Over the past year we have seen an increase in racism towards other minorities such as Muslims and Roma, and growing popular support for organisations and parties whose main focus is on inciting hatred towards these communities.

Given the urgent need for all Member States to implement Framework Decision 2008/913/JHA, I would like to ask the Commission:

1. What specific measures are being taken as part of the bilateral dialogues to ensure the transposition and implementation of the Framework Decision?
2. To what degree have the Member States implemented the measures proposed in the Report on the implementation of Framework Decision 2008/913/JHA (SWD(2014)0027 final)?
