Subject: Aid for improvements to the EN125 highway (Algarve)

People in the Algarve are still calling for urgent improvements to National Highway 125 (EN125), which is known as 'death alley' because of the high accident rate – a situation that has been exacerbated by the introduction of tolls on the Via do Infante motorway, diverting traffic from the motorway to the EN125.

According to local people, the EN125 needs extensive improvements, including the completion of work on potential alternative routes.

What EU funding might be available for improvements to the EN125 and under what conditions?
