Subject: EU's role in the fight against terrorism

A recent Eurobarometer survey shows that EU citizens are increasingly worried about their security, with the proportion of people who see terrorism as the main security challenge in the EU jumping from 33 % on average in 2013 to 49 % today. Considering that the Commission intends to launch an EU forum with major IT companies to counter terrorist propaganda on the internet and in social media, and in view of the need to prioritise the fight against the radicalisation of EU citizens:

Does the Commission intend to design a communication strategy to counter the influence of jihadist groups on the internet?

Does the Commission intend to create an EU knowledge hub on jihadist radicalisation?
