Question for written answer E-010813/2015 to the Commission (Vice-President / High Representative) Rule 130 Javier Couso Permuy (GUE/NGL) and Marina Albiol Guzmán (GUE/NGL)

Subject: VP/HR - Identification of human rights defenders in the European Parliament

At a meeting of the Committee on Political Affairs, Security and Human Rights of the Euro-Latin American Parliamentary Assembly (Eurolat) held on 4 June 2015, the MEPs Luis de Grandes Pascual and Agustín Díaz de Mera referred to Yessika Hoyos, one of the rapporteurs present, as representing an organisation close to the FARC-EP querrilla group.

Their description extended to the work done by the José Alvear Restrepo Lawyers' Collective, which has been the subject of precautionary measures by the Inter-American Commission on Human Rights since 2001, and which is one of the most widely-recognised human rights organisations in Colombia and has even been asked by the Colombian Government to submit a transitional justice proposal under the Havana negotiations.

Statements like this place the lives of the persons identified at great risk.

- 1. Does the High Representative not view statements of this kind as presenting an obstacle to her policy on Colombia?
- 2. Will she take this opportunity to ask Messrs De Grandes and Díaz de Mera to apologise to the person identified and safeguard her work?
