On 10 June 2015 the Commissioner for European Neighbourhood Policy and Enlargement Negotiations, Johannes Hahn, met with senior figures from the four main political parties in the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, in order to continue the discussions aimed at finding a solution to the political crisis that the country is going through. Although the talks were open and detailed – according to the statement released – they did not lead to a final agreement¹.

Given that a final agreement for the Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia is essential if the country is to make any progress on the Euro-Atlantic path, what pending details and issues are standing in the way of a final agreement?
