On 11 June 2015 the Commission announced that a total of EUR 230 million will be released to support the efforts towards sustainable development of Latin America and the Caribbean. This announcement was made at the EU-CELAC Summit held in Brussels on 10 and 11 June. The Commission stated in its press release: 'In order to adapt to this new reality, the EU has set up a Facility for International Cooperation and Partnership. The facility will support the consolidation of peer learning among countries in the Latin American and Caribbean region, and promote joint cooperation with emerging donors in the region. It counts on a budget of EUR 12 million to support the improvement of the design and implementation of public policies with a direct impact on poverty reduction.'1
