Subject: VP/HR - Sousse attacks

Following the attacks at the Bardo Museum in Tunisia on 18 March 2015, High Representative Federica Mogherini said that 'this tragedy strengthens our determination to cooperate more closely with our partners to confront the terrorist threat', before emphasising that terrorist organisations are 'once again targeting the countries and peoples of the Mediterranean'.

The recent attack in Sousse, which cost the lives of 38 people, has highlighted once again the need to step up the fight against terrorism.

1. What specific measures did the High Representative have in mind when she referred to the need for closer cooperation between the EU and the Arab countries which have been victims of terrorist attacks?
2. Has the High Representative estimated the cost of these measures?
3. Can she put a rough figure on that cost?
