Subject: Campaign to protect girls from being abducted by ISIS

Teenage girls are being abducted by Islamic State fighters in Iraq and Syria and being sold in markets for as little as a pack of cigarettes. Abducting girls has also become a key part of the Islamic State strategy to recruit foreign fighters who have been travelling to Iraq and Syria in record numbers over the past 18 months.
