Subject: Castor project: arbitrariness and lack of transparency

In light of the Commission's answer to the Written Question E-003789/2010 ('The Commission has also carried out an investigation of this project. No potential breach of EU environmental law was found') and the Commission's conclusion relating to the petition 0610/2009, stating that it 'considers that no breach of applicable EU environmental legislation could be identified',

1. With five years having passed, does the Commission continue to support the above assertions?
2. Why has it not ordered the Castor site to be shut down, instead allowing the project to remain suspended at a cost of EUR 100-150 million a year?
