Subject: Education system in the Community of Valencia: monitoring and main conclusions regarding the 'Crea Escola' Programme

The provision of high-quality, free education for all citizens of the 28 Member States, which represents one of the great strengths of our successful welfare system, ensures a qualified workforce with equal opportunities based on merit and gives the EU a competitive edge. According to the answer to Written Question E-004115/15, conclusions have been drawn on the basis of complaint SG/E/2014/03 regarding implementation of the 'Crea Escola' programme. The Regional Government of Valencia handed over the Action Plan relating to the deployment and fulfilment of investments in this programme.

- What more or less satisfactory resolutions has the Commission reached with regard to completion of the overall programme?

Although the Commission does not monitor the implementation of investment loans financed by the EIB (answer E-002273/14),

- Does it not believe that the joint supervision of huge investments in areas as essential as education could significantly improve monitoring and implementation schedules, and thus prevent 'modifications or regrettable delays in refurbishing infrastructure sometimes in very urgent need of repair'?
