Subject: Enforcement of Directive 2006/22/EC - roadside checks

Does the Commission agree that, for the road transport sector to operate optimally in the internal market, a level European playing field and the proper application of Directive 2006/22/EC are of the utmost importance?

Is the Commission aware that the Italian Government applies that directive in an extreme and disproportionate fashion?

Is the Commission aware that, even for minor infringements which have to be resolved immediately, the Italian authorities impound goods vehicles for three months, resulting in extremely high costs for the hauliers concerned?
