Subject: How is the European Research Council Executive Agency striving to be representative of the citizens of Europe?

Previously, the Commission has stated that it 'strives to be representative of the increasingly diverse European citizens it serves' (response to Written Questions E-008102/14, E-007850/14 and E-007851/14).

Does the Commission's view mirror that of the European Research Council (ERC) Executive Agency, which comes under the competence of the Commission?
