Subject: Guaranteed free movement of goods in the EU (III)

A number of reports<sup>1</sup> have been published in the media in recent days concerning attacks on lorries carrying Spanish meat in France.

On 22 July 2015, 20 000 kg of meat from Barcelona (Spain) was destroyed in Poitiers (France) in various acts of vandalism, while 2 000 kg of meat from Aragon (Spain) was tipped onto the road in a separate attack in Normandy.

As previously pointed out in written questions P-005742/2014 and E-006609/2014, these are not isolated incidents and they represent a clear violation of Community directives.

What steps has the Commission taken in the past 12 months to prevent such incidents?

What immediate steps will the Commission take to guarantee the right to the free movement of goods in the EU?
