Subject: Dialogue with non-confessional organisations

Under Article 17 of the Lisbon Treaty, the Commission holds meetings both with churches and religious organisations and with non-confessional associations.

- 1. As far as the latter are concerned, can the Commission inform me exactly on what basis it decides which associations should be invited?
- 2. Does the Commission have a representative European list of these associations, and does it take account of their representativeness?
- 3. If the Commission does have such a list, was it compiled in cooperation with the main non-confessional associations or by the Commission acting alone?
- 4. Is the list of associations that are invited to meetings definitive, or can it vary from meeting to meeting?
