Subject: Single European Sky and the Blue Med FAB

The Single European Sky (SES) scheme, under which Member States are required to implement transnational functional airspace blocks (FABs) resulting in more integrated, efficient and flexible air traffic management at regional level, was set up under Regulations (EC) Nos 549/2004, 550/2004, 551/2004 and 552/2004 of 10 March 2004.

Through the agencies with responsibility in this area (ENAV and ENAC), Italy, which forms part of the Blue Med FAB, has provided details of the developments planned for the airspace coming under its authority.

Can the Commission say what information Italy has provided on the use of its national airspace and on any scaling down of the current area control centres?
