Subject: Electricity interconnection target

In the context of the 2020 electricity interconnection target, the Commission is kindly requested to provide more clarity on the following aspects:

- 1. In order to achieve the target, should a Member State interconnect 10 % of its installed capacity with each of its neighbours, or does the 10 % refer to interconnection with all its neighbours combined?
- 2. Do connections with the grids of non-EU countries contribute to the achievement of the target?
- 3. For current and future interconnection targets, does the Commission consider it relevant to differentiate between variable and non-variable energy capacities, given the differing output of the two in an identical nameplate capacity context?
