Subject: EUR 234 million for "racist" Mugabe once again proves impossible to justify

The European delegation of the PVV cannot refrain from maintaining its pressure on the Commission about the free grant of EUR 234 million to Zimbabwe. The PVV wishes that the EU would immediately cease to sponsor Mugabe because, after making racist statements and after the slaughter of elephants, he is again demonstrating his evil ways by making life in Zimbabwe impossible for white farmers<sup>1</sup>.

Mugabe has even said: 'Don't be too kind to white farmers. They can own industries and companies, or stay in apartments in our towns but they cannot own land. They must leave the land to blacks.'

- 1. Does the Commission consider that Mugabe has once again demonstrated that he is a racist and that, for white people in Zimbabwe, life is being rendered more and more dangerous and impossible by the day as a result of his policy and statements?
- 2. Will the Commission therefore immediately halt all forms of EU aid to Zimbabwe and to Mugabe?
- 3. In previous replies to written questions<sup>2</sup>, the Commission states that 'implementation (of the EUR 234 million) is entrusted mostly to international organisations or NGOs'. Can the Commission demonstrate which organisations these are? Please supply a list.
