Subject: Dublin/infringement proceedings

1. Does the Commission consider that the way in which the refugee issue has been handled by the Member States Hungary, Greece, Italy, Spain, France and Austria is legally compatible with the legal commitments undertaken under the Dublin agreement?
2. If it takes the view that some of these countries have been acting contrary to EU law: what progress has it made in initiating infringement proceedings?
3. How can the Commission, as guardian of the Treaties, justify the fact that it is treating some Member States differently from others, even though they are guilty of similar infringements?
