Subject: Refugee registration centre in Röszke (Hungary)

In recent weeks, large numbers of refugees who have managed to enter Hungary from Serbia have been sent to a 'registration centre' near Röszke, where they are registered before being relocated to various detention centres around the country, the locations of which have not been made public. Apparently, many are transferred to the Austrian border, others are released and others may even be being sent back to Serbia.

Is the Commission aware of the way in which the Hungarian authorities are managing the influx of refugees, and what the criteria are for sending them to one destination or another?

Does the Commission have any information on the network of detention centres that the Hungarian authorities have set up? Does it have access to that network, or to the list of people registered at the Röszke registration centre?

Is the Commission aware of the conditions for refugees detained in the Röszke detention centre, or in the other centres? How long do the refugees stay and how many of them are there?
