Subject: Impact of new forms of employment

One of the targets for the Europe 2020 strategy, which provides guidance for EU policies, is to achieve an employment rate of 75 %. All of the European institutions are now in agreement that it will be impossible to reach this target unless there is a drastic change in circumstances.

In parallel, the labour market is currently evolving, with the emergence of new forms of employment that are radically altering people's work prospects and employer relations. The resulting labour market will be completely transformed.

1. With this in mind, has the Commission carried out, or has it any plans to carry out, an impact assessment to ascertain the actual effects of these new forms of employment on the labour market?
2. Is the Commission aware that this target employment rate of 75 % is impossible to achieve, and does it intend to remove the target from the Europe 2020 strategy?
