Question for written answer E-013784/2015 to the Commission Rule 130 Santiago Fisas Ayxelà (PPE)

Subject: Generalitat of Catalonia's cinema law

Further to

- written questions E-007389/2010, E-007567/2011, E-013742/2013 and P-006265/2015, previously put to the Commission;
- and Mr Oettinger's answer of 8 June 2015 on behalf of the Commission, stating that it had
 received assurances from the Catalan government that it would amend the law to bring it in
 conformity with EC law, and that in April 2014 the Commission had been informed that amending
 legislation addressing important points raised in the Reasoned Opinion was under review in the
 Catalan parliament;
- and given the fact that on 3 August the Catalan parliament was dissolved without approving these amendments, 15 months after the Catalan government informed the Commission of its intentions and 15 months after the draft law was put to the parliament,
- 1. Does the Commission not think that three years is sufficient for the Catalan government to amend a law, given that the official deadline given in the reasoned opinion was two months?
- When does the Commission intend to decide on whether to refer the matter to the Court of Justice?
