Subject: Migration into the European Union

There is currently no bigger topic for popular debate than legal and illegal migration into the EU. The following questions need to be answered if the tasks to be completed and the dangers which will ensue for Europe's welfare states and the identity of Europe's peoples are to be properly addressed:

1. How many migrants arrived in the EU in 2014 and the first half of 2015? How many of them were asylum-seekers? Please provide a breakdown by gender and country of origin.
2. How many migrants who were unlawfully in the EU were sent home (deported) in 2014 and the first half of 2015? Please provide a breakdown by each Member State.
3. Does the Commission have plans to support countries / local authorities to ensure that thousands of asylum-seekers do not have to live in tents and can be given humane accommodation?
