Subject: Situation in Montenegro

Large-scale political protests are currently being held in Montenegro. In the capital, Podgorica, thousands of people are protesting against the government and calling for new elections. The main organisation behind the protests is the coalition of opposition parties known as the Democratic Front (Demokratski Front), led by Andrija Mandić and opposed to Montenegro joining NATO. The protesters are calling for the Prime Minister, Milo Đukanović, to resign by next Saturday.

What is the Commission doing to prevent the possible destabilisation of Montenegro, a country which is in process of EU integration, given that such destabilisation would have negative effects on the stability of the entire region?
