Subject: Humanitarian crisis in Ukraine

According to data published by the Commission's DG ECHO, about 1.41 million people in Ukraine are Internally Displaced People, and 1.1 million have become refugees in neighbouring countries. Moreover, taking into account that about 5 million people in Ukraine need humanitarian aid and bearing in mind that access to such aid is becoming more difficult in various parts of eastern Ukraine, one may expect that should there be further escalation of the hybrid war in Ukraine the inflow of refugees from that country will increase.

- 1. Does the Commission have specific plans concerning a possible massive inflow of refugees from behind the EU's eastern border? If so, what are they?
- 2. Does the Commission plan to increase humanitarian aid in Ukraine?
