- 1. Was the European Union, and specifically the Commission, aware that these passports were being issued, and is it known who made the relevant arrangements with the Afghan Government and what those arrangements entail?
- 2. How are the one million passport holders to be divided among the various European countries and on what basis?
- 3. Are there any further plans to issue millions of passports to enable people from crisis-stricken countries to travel to Europe and, if so, from which countries?
