Question for written answer E-014352/2015 to the Commission Rule 130 Franck Proust (PPE)

Subject: Monitoring air traffic

On 29 October 2015 the Commission was asked about the development of a satellite-based technology which would provide the basis for global flight-tracking systems.

- 1. How, in the Commission's view, can the security of communications within such systems be guaranteed? We must ensure that all communications and exchanges of data between pilots, aircraft and air-traffic control services are protected: hacking and other attempts at sabotage are becoming ever more frequent, yet they are rarely discussed. The threat is real.
- 2. The use of this new technology will inevitably generate new industrial demand. Can Europe capitalise on its expertise to promote its own flight-tracking technology in this emerging market? From major projects come major innovations, particularly in the aerospace sector.
