Subject: Review of the sale of the Nürburgring in the light of European law

Further to the actions brought by certain defeated bidders against the sale of the Nürburgring, the Commission intends to reassess the transaction, particularly with reference to the resale of the Nürburgring to a Russian investor.

1. Is it true that the Commission intends to uphold its previous view that the sale complied with European law?
2. What documents concerning the procedure adopted for the sale does the Commission have at its disposal, and does it regard them as sufficient to enable it to make a careful and independent assessment?
3. Will the Commission permit public access to all the documents at its disposal?
