Subject: Measures to prevent radicalisation within the Member States

The tragic events in Paris have shown that it is necessary to not only crack down on radicalisation, but also formulate upstream cross-cutting policies with a view to averting as far as possible some of the causes of radicalisation, including social policies, education, employment, integration, intercultural dialogue and community programmes.

However, it is frequently these policies that bear the brunt of the austerity measures advocated by the Commission.
