## Question for written answer E-000226/2016 to the Commission Rule 130 Bart Staes (Verts/ALE)

Subject: Interpretation of 'available means' in Regulation (EC) No 1107/2009

According to Directive 2009/128/EC, pesticide use should be based on sustainable practices/IPM. However, the new derogation (Article 4.7 of Regulation 1107/2009) for the very pesticides that are most harmful might undermine this goal.

- 1. On what criteria do DG SANCO and EFSA base their assessment of 'available means'?
- 2. How does the Commission guarantee that the serious danger to plant health cannot be contained by other 'available means' including non-chemical methods?
- 3. Does the Commission agree that 'available means' does not include a whole range of alternatives to combat 'resistance', since resistance is caused by bad agricultural practices (monocultures, overdosing with pesticides, weak varieties) and is only worsened by increased spraying?
