The Campact campaign leader Lara Dovifat announced recently that the European Patent Office grants multinational companies full and exclusive rights over naturally cultivated food. This creates a monopoly over what we eat. More than 120 natural foods have already been patented – 1 000 patent applications await a decision. They have been filed by giant companies such as Monsanto, Bayer or Syngenta.

- 1. Who bears the political responsibility for granting these patents?
- 2. How long are these patents valid for and can they be terminated?
- 3. Is it, in the Commission's opinion, morally right or even legal for patents on food to be sold?
