Subject: Establishment of an entry register in the Commission

As far as we are aware, the Commission does not have an entry register allowing citizens to submit documents and receive stamped copies in evidence of this.

The European Union also lacks a postal or electronic service for certifying the content of documents, which means that members of the public have no way of proving that they have delivered communications to the Commission, either in person or by mail or electronically.

Be that as it may, can Commission confirm that it has no such register?

If this is indeed the case, does it intend to open a service for the registration of documents received at its headquarters in Brussels and at its offices in the various Member States?
