Subject: Assessment of measures to tackle radicalisation and the recruitment of EU citizens by terrorist organisations

A European policy to tackle terrorism and prevent radicalisation is urgently needed in order to improve the security of EU citizens.

On 25 November 2015, Parliament adopted my report on preventing radicalisation and the recruitment of EU citizens by terrorist organisations, which was an important step forward. The report, which had cross-party support, contains clear proposals which must be implemented quickly.

Assessing the strategy itself and the steps Member States have taken to implement it is an important part of the process. To that end, it is essential to analyse not only the current security threats in Europe, but also the efforts made to deal with them.

Will the Commission draw up an annual report on the security situation in Europe, as recommended in my report?

If so, who will be involved in the assessment process?
